

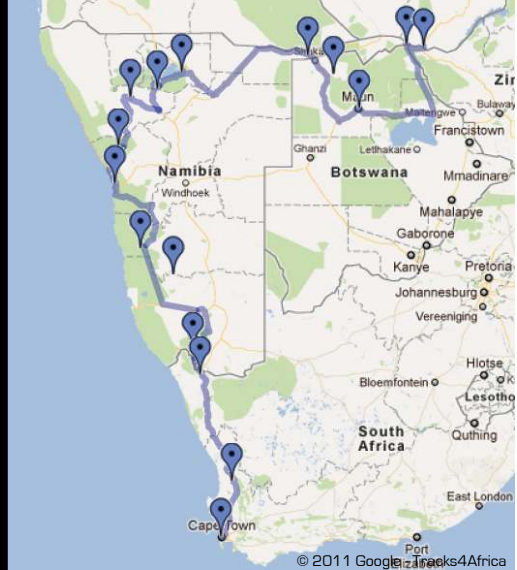
Desert & Water Wanderer Cape Town - Victoria Falls: 21 Days

The Desert and Water Wanderer is a three week adventure for those who want to experience the wildlife and spectacular landscapes in southern Africa. Take in the sights of Namibia, Botswana and Victoria Falls.

Day	Full Itinerary - Itinerary is a guide only & some alterations may occur.	Inclusive Highlights (Indicated as red text)
1	After a leisurely departure from Cape Town we head round Table Bay and stop off to buy fresh produce and view Table Mountain from Blaauwberg (weather permitting) before heading North and spending our first night on an operating wine farm. Spend the evening tasting wines from the Olifants River Valley region. (▲) (X - B L D)	View Table Mountain across Table Bay from Blaauwberg. Wine Farm
2-3	We head for Namibia crossing the border and camping the night on the Orange River. An optional canoe trip the following morning whets your appetite for the days to come. We then head for the Fish River Canyon and have a sundowner on the canyon's rim. (▲) (X - B L D)	Canoe trip on Orange River. Fish River Canyon.
4-5	The next morning we travel to the dramatic red sand dunes of Sossusvlei in the Namib Desert. Overnight Sesriem campsite, allowing us to get to Dune 45 in the heart of the dune region to see the sunrise, followed by a short drive to the Sossusvlei area we then take a 4x4 transfer to explore the area. Heading back to camp we have lunch before packing up camp and moving on to a private farm to camp that night under the stars of a Namib sky, next morning before it gets too hot we will take a desert tour and learn how the original San (bushmen) people survived off the land. (▲) (X - B L D)	Arrive at Sesriem. Sunrise from Dune 45 & transfer to Sossusvlei. Guided Desert tour on a private wilderness area.
6-7	After the tranquility of the desertscape, we increase the pace, heading for the old German town of Swakopmund where sand-boarding, quad-biking and tandem sky-diving feature among numerous activities on offer. Alternatively take a relaxing stroll around the shops and buildings, enjoying the colonial architecture of this seaside holiday town. (☒) (X - B L D)	Arrive in Swakopmund. Optional activities at own expense
8	Leaving Swakopmund, we travel up the coast and visit the Cape Cross seal colony before heading inland. We spend the night at Brandberg (burning mountain), Namibia's highest peak, and take a short walk in the mountain foothills to see the well-known "White Lady" bushman rock painting. (▲) (X - B L D)	Cape Cross Seal Colony. Brandberg – "White lady" bushman paintings.
9	Leaving the Brandberg behind us we next travel to a cheetah conservation project where you have the opportunity to interact with these very special mammals. (▲) (X - B L D)	Cheetah conservation farm.
10-12	Next day we leave for Etosha, where we spend the next 3 nights. Here we game drive through the park, relax at the campsite pools and watch the "nightlife" at the floodlit waterholes. (▲) (X - B L D)	Game driving in Etosha National Park
13	Heading east from Etosha we make our way to the Caprivi Strip where we camp on the Kavango River. (▲) (X - B L D)	Kavango River
14-16	We then cross the border into Botswana, making our way to the pan-handle of the Okavango region. Transfer with 4x4 truck and motorboats. The Delta trip is a true wilderness where we are limited to taking only what will fit into our mokoro (dugout canoes) - an exceptional African adventure. (▲) (X - B L D)	Okavango Delta.
17	Leaving the Delta we head to Maun where we have the afternoon to relax, or take an optional scenic flight over the Delta, affording a different perspective on this unique inland waterway. (▲) (X - B L D)	Maun. Optional scenic flight
18-19	Leaving Maun we head north to the Chobe National Park and spend 2 nights camping on the banks of the Chobe River. Early the following morning we take a game drive into the park in search of the big five. In the evening we explore the river on a motorboat, where the sunset frames the wide variety of game and bird life. (▲) (X - B L D)	Game drive and Boat Cruise in Chobe National Park.
20-21	Leaving Botswana behind we enter Zimbabwe/Zambia and a short drive brings us to the Victoria Falls. Depending how long our border crossing takes we will visit the falls on the Zambia side and take a sunset river cruise on the Zambezi. Your last full day on tour can be spent doing one or several of the numerous activities on offer such as white water rafting, flights over the falls or elephant back riding to name just a few. (▲) (X - B L D)	Victoria Falls National Park. Sunset cruise on the Zambezi River. Optional activities at own expense.

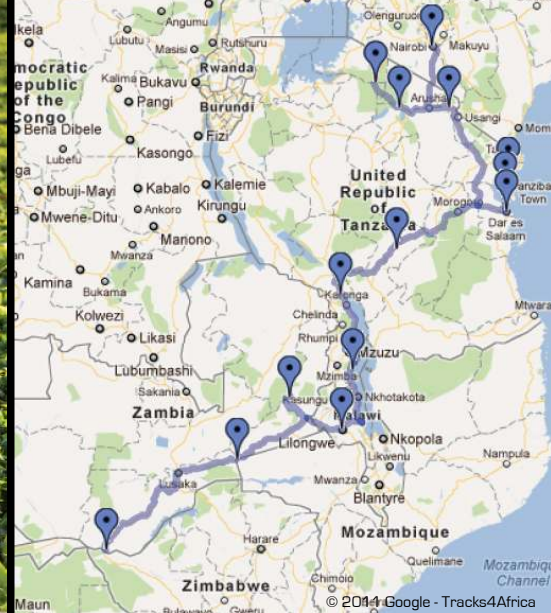
Northern Explorer

Day	Full Itinerary - Itinerary is a guide only & some alterations may occur.	Inclusive Highlights (Indicated as red text)
1 - 2	Starting at the Victoria Falls in Zambia you will be able to visit the falls on the Zambian side and in the afternoon take a sunset river cruise to celebrate your arrival on tour. On the second day do any of the number of activities on offer around the falls area like white water rafting or a micro-light flight over the Batoka Gorge. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Zambezi Sunset cruise. Victoria Falls National Park.
3	We then head through the heart of Zambia past Lusaka, camping on the banks of the South Luangwa River (▲) (✕ - B L D)	
4 - 5	Today we arrive at South Luangwa National Park. This is a less frequently visited game park and there is a better chance of seeing shy leopard here. We spend 2 nights here, camping on the banks of the Luangwa River, where visits by elephant and other wildlife are not uncommon. While here we do a morning and evening game drive in the hope of spotting the elusive leopard and other more common game. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Arrive at South Luangwa National Park. Morning and afternoon Game drives
6	With a short drive to Malawi you can do an optional game walk before leaving this beautiful valley behind. We exit Zambia heading for Lilongwe, the capital of Malawi. Spending the night in the capital you have time to do curio shopping at the local ebony market while your crew stock up on provisions for the following days on the shores of Lake Malawi. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Travel to Lilongwe.
7 - 8	For the next two days, soak up the sun, enjoy the water sports and explore the local culture. Participate in various watersports on offer on the Lake. Horse riding also available. Visit a local village and sample the local cuisine if you wish. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Arrive on Lake Malawi. Kande Beach.
9	Driving north up the lake we leave Malawi and enter Tanzania, spending the night near a small town called Tukuyu. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	
10	Up early the next morning we visit a local Tea plantation which is a local community project, after which we continue driving north to camp at a farmhouse in the highlands of Tanzania. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Local Community Tea Plantation visit
11	Another early departure takes us further into Tanzania. We also pass briefly through Mukumi National Park. We head for Dar-es-Salaam and spend the night at a campsite on the seashore. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Dar-es-Salaam.
12 - 14	The following 3 nights are spent on Zanzibar where you have the chance to explore this exotic spice island at your leisure. Discover the intricate streets of Stone Town and its people, take a spice tour or swim with dolphins at the southern tip of the island. (☒) (✕ - Own expense while on island)	Return Ferry to Zanzibar Zanzibar transfers.
15 - 16	Returning to the mainland, we camp near Dar again before departing for Arusha. Heading north we have a long day passing through many African villages and, if the weather favours us, we may catch sight of snow-capped Kilimanjaro, the highest peak in Africa, spending the night camping in the foothills of Kilimanjaro. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Kilimanjaro
17 - 18	Next morning we head into Arusha town to do some curio shopping after which we head for the Ngorongoro crater, spending the night at a town near the crater rim. Up early next morning, we use local operators for a day's excursion down into the crater in search of game including lion, hyena, rhino and elephant, returning to camp by late afternoon. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Ngorongoro Crater 4x4 safari.
19 - 20	Today you have the option to visit the Serengeti national Park with a local operator for one night, there will be time for an afternoon and morning game drive. (▲) (✕ - B L D)	Optional Serengeti 2 day/1 night tour with local 4x4 operator.
21	We spend the final day of our tour crossing the border into Kenya, heading for the capital Nairobi. - TOUR ENDS ON ARRIVAL IN NAIROBI. (✕ - B L)
